



## HỌC ANH NGỮ TRÊN ĐÀI VOA

Đây là Chương trình Anh Ngữ Sinh Động New Dynamic English bài 163. Phạm Văn xin kính chào quý vị thính giả. Trong bài học hôm nay, ta học về 1 a chọn, this program will teach you how to talk about making choices. To make a choice, to choose=chọn. Ôn lại: to choose là động từ bất quy tắc: to choose/chose/chosen. Check câu bài hôm nay là "Will you accept the job?" bạn có nhận việc làm đó không? Trong bài học, Chris Scott, vũ nữ cổ điển ballet, muốn đi làm tại Chicago thay vì Washington. Ballet=kịch múa theo nhạc cổ điển (classical music), không là, như tích truyện Hồ Thiên nga Swan Lake của Tchaikovsky. Diễn viên vũ ballet, ngoài chữ ballet dancer còn gọi là ballerina.

MUSIC

Max (voice-over): Hi, I'm Max.

Kathy (voice-over): Hello. My name is Kathy.

Max and Kathy (voice-over): Welcome to New Dynamic English!

MUSIC up and then fade

Larry: New Dynamic English is a basic English language course and an introduction to American people and culture.

Today's unit is "Will You Accept the Job?"

This program will teach you how to talk about making choices.

## MUSIC

Kathy: Hi, Max.

Max: Hi, Kathy.

Who's our guest today?

Kathy: Today our guest is Chris Scott.

She was on our show before, with her sister, Sara Scott.

Chris is a ballet dancer.

Max: Oh yes, she lives in Chicago.

Kathy: That's right.

## MUSIC

Trong ph n t i, Larry h i chuy n Chris Scott v i vi c cô ta mu n xin vào làm đi n viên khiêu vũ cho m t vũ đoàn ở Washington. To have an interview=vào ph ng v n v i n i mình xin vi c làm. Offer a job=nh n cho làm vi c. To accept a job.=nh n làm m t vi c. To move=d n nhà. Make a decision=quy t đ nh, to decide. A difficult decision.=m t quy t đ nh khó. To miss=nh . I'll miss my friends=tôi s nh các b n tôi. I am not sure what I'll do.=tôi không bi t ph i làm gì. I love living with my sister Sara.=tôi thích s ng v i bà ch Sara c a tôi. I like living in Chicago.=tôi thích s ng ở Chicago. [Nh n xét: sau đ ng t love và like, đ ng t theo sau có th dùng ở hình th c verb-ing.]

Interview. Chris Scott: Where do you live?

Larry: Interview

Chris has applied for a job with a dance company in Washington, DC.=Chris đã xin vi c làm t i m t vũ đoàn khiêu vũ ở Washington, D.C.

This morning I had an interview with a dance company. Sáng nay tôi vào ph ng v n xin vi c làm v i m t vũ đoàn.

Do you think they'll offer you a job? B n có nghĩ là h s cho b n vi c làm không?

If I accept the job, I'll have to move to Washington. N u tôi nh n vi c ỳ thì tôi ph i d n nhà v Washington.

Kathy: Our guest today is Chris Scott.

Welcome back, Chris.

Chris: Thank you.

Kathy: How are things?

Chris: Very interesting, actually.

You know, I dance with a ballet company in Chicago.

Kathy: Yes.

Chris: Well, this morning I had an interview with a dance company here in Washington, DC.

Kathy: Really? How did it go?

Chris: I think I did OK.

Kathy: Do you think they'll offer you a job?

Chris: Well, I think so.

Kathy: If they offer you a job, will you accept?

Chris: I'm not sure what I'll do.

I like living in Chicago.

I have a lot of friends there.

And I love living with my sister Sara.

If I accept the job, I'll have to move to Washington.

I'll miss my sister and I'll miss all my friends in Chicago.

Kathy: That sounds like a difficult decision.

Chris: Yes.

However, they may not offer me the job.

And then I won't have to make a decision.

Kathy: True.

Our guest is Chris Scott. We'll talk more after our break.

Trong ph n t i, ta ôn i m y nhóm ch : Apply for a job=xin vi c làm. To go to an interview=vào ph ng v n khi xin vi c làm. To offer someone a job=nh n cho ai m t vi c làm. To make a decision.=quy t đ nh. To move=d n nhà. Dance=khiêu vũ; a dancer=đi n viên vũ; a dance company=m t vũ đoàn (ban vũ).

Washington Ballet Company is a well-known dance company=Washington Ballet là m t vũ đoàn c đĩ n ballet danh ti ng. Large=l n; larger=l n h n. Famous=danh ti ng; more famous than=danh ti ng h n. Nh là "well-known," đ c nhi u ng i bi t ti ng, khi đ i sang th so sánh "h n" thì thành "better-known." [Có đ u n i gi better và known.] Salary=l ng b ng. If they won't offer her a job, she won't have to make a decision.=n u h không cho cô vi c làm, thì cô kh i ph i quy t đ nh. If they offer her a job, and if she accepts it, she'll have to move to Washington,=n u h cho cô vi c làm, và n u cô nh n, thì cô ph i d n nhà xu ng Washington. However=tuy nhiên [có đ u ph y sau however.]

Larry: Listen and repeat.

Max: This morning Chris had an interview with a dance company.

(pause for repeat)

Max: They may offer her a job.

(pause for repeat)

Max: If they offer her a job, she's not sure what she'll do.

(pause for repeat)

Max: If she accepts the job, she'll have to move to Washington.

(pause for repeat)

Max: However, they may not offer her the job.

(pause for repeat)

Max: If they don't offer her the job, she won't have to make a decision.

(pause for repeat)

Interview 2. Chris Scott: Which dance company is better?

Larry: Interview

Chris compares the dance company in Chicago with the Washington company. Chris so sánh vũ đoàn Chicago v i vũ đoàn Washington.

The Chicago company is larger, but the Washington company is more famous. Vũ đoàn Chicago l n h n, nh ng vũ đoàn Washington n i ti ng h n.

Kathy: Now it's time for today's interview.



Our guest today is Chris Scott.

She lives in Chicago, but she may move to Washington, DC.

Chris, which dance company is larger, the one in Chicago or the one here in Washington?

Chris: Well, the Chicago company is larger, but the Washington company is more famous.

And the salaries are higher.

Kathy: So if you move to Washington, you'll make more money.

Chris: Yes, and more people will see me dance.

I may even become famous.

Kathy: Our guest is Chris Scott. We'll talk more after our break.

Kathy: We're back with our guest, Chris Scott.

You have a dog, don't you?

Chris: Yes, his name's Woody.

Kathy: If you move to Washington, will you bring Woody with you?

Chris: Of course!

Wherever I go, Woody goes.

I won't move to Washington without him!

Now, when I go out of town, Sara stays with Woody.

In Washington, I'll have to have a roommate.

So that if I go out of town, somebody will stay with Woody.

He gets very lonely.

Chris: Thank you, Kathy. I enjoyed it.
